# ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS IN NAZARÉ:

Three lodgings with simple and cozy accommodation. Capacity for about 30 people, with breakfast included.

 Camps can be mounted in two schools of Nazareth. There is one primary school and one high school with the capacity and structure to accommodate all the registered. It is important to note that those interested should bring their tents, mattresses or sleeping bags.

#### **FEEDING**

- It features a restaurant with the best seasoning of the Madeira River, as it is known.
- It will be offered a collaborative kitchen for people who choose beforehand.

### SHUTTLE

- Air flight: The participant must notify the local committee of MINOM about the day and hour of arrival/departure and the hotel chosen for hosting in Porto Velho.
- Departure to Nazaré: on August 3rd, from 8 am. We will have a bus with itinerary passing by hotels and leading participants to the Cai N'água port.
- Return from Nazaré: on August 7th, with the arrival of the boat at 8 pm. One bus will take participants from Cai N'água port to the hotels.

# **BASIC GUIDELINES:**

- For better comfort during your trip to Nazaré, bring hammocks with ropes to tie them on the boat;
- Personal belongings and camping items;

- In Nazareth we do not have Internet access and cell phone signal; (Only in the high school we have a limited internet access);
- Bring swimsuits.
